The Tesla 'EVIP' program is the latest in a series of award-winning [sustainability initiatives](#) introduced by The Cliffs, aligned with UN sustainability pillars.

The partnership also represents Envoy's first foray into Hawaii's hospitality market, with the delivery of two Tesla Model 3's in Princeville on December 6, 2022. With the use of a simple app, guests and owners at The Cliffs at Princeville will enjoy the freedom of sustainable transportation without the hassle and expense of traditional car rental services.

"It's firstly a convenience," says Cliffs General Manager Jim Braman, "but it's also a premium amenity, allowing our guests to venture out and explore the island in a very nice ride."

"We are forging a new pathway to sustainable travel by partnering with The Cliffs at Princeville," says Ori Sagie, co-founder and CEO of Envoy Technologies. "EV on demand car rentals reduce the carbon footprint of visitors at a time when rental car availability and price increases have often left travelers scrambling for alternative mobility options."

For travelers visiting Kauai, The Cliffs at Princeville's partnership with Envoy Hawaii strategically solves this problem. Resort guests and owners can use the Envoy Mobility app to reserve the cars by the hour, the day, or their entire stay.

“In remote destinations like our own, with limited roadways, electric vehicle sharing is the future,” Braman adds. “We’re making it easy and fun, as a natural complement to a [regenerative travel stay](#).”

Creating an electric car share offering for the hospitality industry is a natural progression for Envoy, as it expands from a business originating in multifamily housing and office building sectors.

Vehicle charging stations have been added at The Cliffs, where solar powered suites and Tesla batteries already generate over 80% of the resort’s energy needs. On average, 30% of the energy generated is returned to a power grid managed by Kauai’s Independent Utility Co-op (KIUC.) The island of Kauai, powered by almost 70% renewable energy, is at the forefront of Hawaii’s renewable energy transition.

With plans already set for Envoy’s future expansion in hospitality, The Cliffs at Princeville is setting the bar for innovative eco-tourism on a pathway aligned with Hawaii Tourism’s Malama ‘Āina mandate.

“Electric car sharing is a good and strategic move,” concludes Braman. “In combination with programs such as Kauai’s North Shore shuttle, the overall impact is to reduce emissions and vehicle miles traveled on the island.”
